



# Ferret Egg Carton Tracker

## Instructions (Estimated Total Time: 20–25 min):

### Items Needed:

- Printable ferret and 6 medallions
- Half egg carton (cut lengthwise)
- 1 strip of light green construction paper
- 1 strip of dark green construction paper
- Popsicle stick
- Coloring supplies
- Glue
- Scissors

1. Prepare the egg carton. (2–3 min)
  - Cut a small slit in the bottom of each egg well, just big enough for the popsicle stick to fit.
2. Cut the pieces. (4–5 min)
  - Cut out the ferret and all 6 medallions.
3. Set the goal benchmarks. (2–3 min)
  - Choose your own benchmarks to reach your personal goal. Write one benchmark on each medallion, with the final goal on the sixth medallion.
4. Attach the ferret. (2–3 min)
  - Glue the ferret to the popsicle stick, leaving space at the bottom so it can slide into the egg carton slits.
5. Make the grass strips. (3–4 min)
  - Cut slits halfway down the long edge of each green paper strip.
  - Roll or curl the cut edges to look like grass.
6. Add the grass to the carton. (2–3 min)
  - Glue both green strips to one side of the upside-down egg carton, layering them slightly.
7. Add the medallions. (2–3 min)
  - Glue the medallions in order on the other side of the egg carton, one above each egg well.
  - When using, move the ferret along the slits to show each benchmark reached.
