## What do we do?

Move the bird, or make a quiet safety circle around it.



# The Stray Cat

Two friends see a skinny cat near a trash can.

“It looks hungry! We should give it our snacks,” one friend says.

“We should leave food nearby and step back so it feels safe,” the other says.

## What do we do?

Feed the cat directly, or place food down and step back.



# The Turtles on the Trail

Two friends a turtle slowly crossing a walking path.

“It’s so slow! We should pick it up and move it,” one friend says.

“We shouldn’t bother it. It can do it! We should block the path so people don’t bump into it,” the other says.

## What do we do?

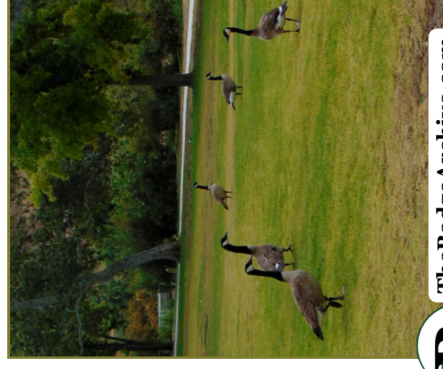
Pick up the frog, or tip the bucket to let it escape.
